COVID-19 vaccines are here in Indian River County but supplies from the government have been and continue to be very limited in our communities.



Please be patient and understand that as vaccines are entering our county, they are coming into our local Department of Health and Cleveland Clinic Indian River Hospital only. They are managing the distribution process, and partnering with community healthcare organizations to provide the vaccine to you as quickly as possible according to Federal and State orders.

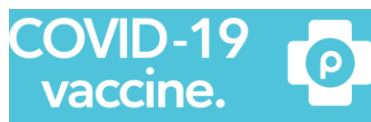
