General Information & Instructions

The Indian River County Hospital District is committed to support healthy living in our community. Each year, the District upholds this commitment by awarding funding to organizations that provide health or health-related services and/or programs to residents within Indian River County.

Our Mission & Vision:

Mission: To Ensure Access to Care and Services Resulting in Improved Health Outcomes.

Vision: Working to Improve the Health of our Community through a Collaborative Effort.

It is the intention of the Trustees of the Indian River County Hospital District to ensure, to the best of their abilities, that approved funding requests for health services are consistent with the District's Vision Statement and its funding guidelines. The Trustees recognize the importance of adapting and responding to change and encourage innovative approaches to meeting the health needs of the community. Every effort will be made to be objective, and use standardized decision methods and approaches in the review of agencies requests so all applications are treated consistently and fairly. The guidelines, which follow, are to be used as one of several considerations in funding agencies and programs.

Funding is distributed on an October 1 – September 30 cycle, although programs are not required to operate on the same fiscal year.

Applications Process and Deadlines

Applications will be made available to organizations by February 4, 2022 and shall be received by the District no later than the March 25, 2022 deadline.

Funding Eligibility

The Hospital District evaluates programs on their ability to provide the highest quality services which best address the key focus areas identified by the community needs assessment.

Applications are evaluated using the following criteria:

- Support access to programs and services that support the mission and vision of the Indian River County Hospital District to foster a healthy community.

- Provide and maintain, Medical, Psychological/Psychiatric/Behavioral, Dental, Substance Use Disorder treatment and Home Health/Hospice healthcare programs and services as are needed for the general welfare of individuals and families of and in Indian River County.
- Support programs and services which promote and improve the physical and mental health and well-being of all residents.
- Provide for the connection to Specialty Medical and Psychological services.
- Support programs that educate and prevent risky behaviors and substance (alcohol/drugs) use and abuse.
- Provide for prenatal/postnatal care programs and services, particularly those improving birth outcomes and healthy behaviors.
- Provide for, support and coordinate recruitment, training, and professional development of healthcare workers in Indian River County, which will ultimately improve service delivery and desired outcomes for all residents.
- Support efforts that consult, coordinate and collaborate with local, state and national entities which promote best practices focusing on health programs and services that improve the health of the community.
- New programs from currently funded agencies and non-funded agencies are eligible for one year funding. In order to be eligible for a second year of funding for same program, the program must have one-year of satisfactory outcome performance and relationship with the District.

Additional Requirements.

- Copy of Strategic Plan, if available
- Current Board of Directors list.
- Organization, program and/or capital project budget.
- Historical and current financial information is to be supplied by requesting agency, to include alternate funding sources (See Schedule 1 & 2)
- Copy of most recent independent audited financial statement for organizations with annual operating budgets under \$1,000,000.

Application Review and Evaluation Criteria

- All agencies requesting funding will be required to submit progress reports on a semi-annual basis.
- All agencies requesting funding will be required to submit a clear description of specific use of requested funds and the results to be achieved.
- All agencies requesting funding will be required to provide meaningful measurable benchmarks and indicators of success.
